Lori La Bey is a passionate and inspiring keynote speaker and the founder of Alzheimer's Speaks, a Minnesota based advocacy group and media outlet making an international impact by providing education and support for those dealing with Alzheimer's disease and other dementias. Her own mother struggled with dementia for over 30 years. In 2011, she started Alzheimer's Speaks Radio, along with the first webinar series called, "Dementia Chats™," whose experts are those diagnosed with the disease. David Geldmacher, MD

Dr. David Geldmacher is the Professor of Neurology and Director of the Division of Memory Disorders and Behavioral Neurology at the UAB School of Medicine. He leads UAB's Memory Disorder Clinics, which focus on the care of people with Alzheimer's disease, and conducts clinical testing of new drugs for Alzheimer's. In 2014 he began the first -of-its-type Alzheimer's Risk Assessment and Intervention Clinic to help people understand their risks for developing dementia, and implement lifestyle changes to keep the risk as low as possible. Come hear Dr. Geldmacher speak on the latest advances in Alzheimer's research and non-pharmacological approaches.
